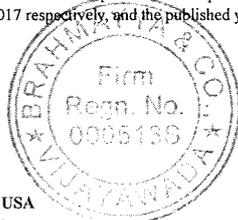

## Notes:

- These financial results were reviewed and recommended by the Audit Committee at their meeting held on May 14, 2018 and approved by the Board of Directors at their meeting held on May 18, 2018. These results are as per Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 as modified by Circular No.CIR/CFD/FAC/62/2016 dated July 5, 2016. The statutory auditors have carried out an audit of these results for the year ended March 31, 2018.
- The Board of Directors at its meeting held on May 18, 2018 has recommended a dividend of 26% (₹ 2.15 per equity share of face value of ₹ 1 each) which is subject to approval of the shareholders. Interim dividend of ₹ 2 per equity share of face value of ₹ 1 each approved by the Board of Directors at its meeting held on November 9, 2017 was paid during the previous quarter. The total dividend (including interim dividend) for FY 2017-18 amounts to ₹ 4.15 per equity share (Previous year ₹ 4.25 per equity share).
- The Government of India introduced the Good and Service Tax (GST) with effect from July 01, 2017. Accordingly, in compliance with Ind AS 18 'Revenue', revenue from operations for the period beginning July 1, 2017 to March 31, 2018 is presented net of GST. Revenue from operations of earlier periods included Excise duty which now is subsumed in GST.
- The Company is engaged in the manufacture and marketing of lead acid storage batteries, which in the context of Indian Accounting Standard (Ind AS) -108 Operating Segments, is considered as the operating segment of the company.
- The figures of the current quarter and the quarter ended March 31, 2017 are balancing figures between the audited figures of the full financial year ended March 31, 2018 and March 31, 2017 respectively, and the published year to date figures upto third quarter ended December 31, 2017 and December 31, 2016, respectively.

**INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT  
TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF

1. We have audited the accompanying Statement of Financial Results of **AMARA RAJA BATTERIES LIMITED** ("the Company"), for the year ended March 31, 2018 ("the Statement"), being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as modified by Circular No. CIR/CFD/FAC/62/2016 dated July 5, 2016.
2. This Statement, which is the responsibility of the Company's Management and approved by the Board of Directors, has been compiled from the related Ind AS financial statements which has been prepared in accordance with the Indian Accounting Standards prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued thereunder ('Ind AS') and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on the Statement based on our audit of such financial statements.
3. We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. Those Standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the Statement is free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and the disclosures in the Statement. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the Statement, whether due to fraud or error. 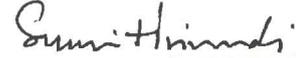
